Yashua comes to Bethany 6 days before Passover Lazarus, Mary and Matha make him supper John 12:1-3

After "two days is the "Feast Day" the son of man is to be "crucified" Judas talks with the Priests to betray Yashua Two days before Passover the chief priests seek to betray Yashua Matt. 26:1-6 Luke 22:1-6 Mark 14:1-3

Women rested on Sabbath according to the "commandment" High Sabbath Chief Priest ask pilot for a guard for the tomb When "Sabbath" was past Luke 23:55-56 John 19:28-31 Matt. 27:62-63 Mark 16:1-2
